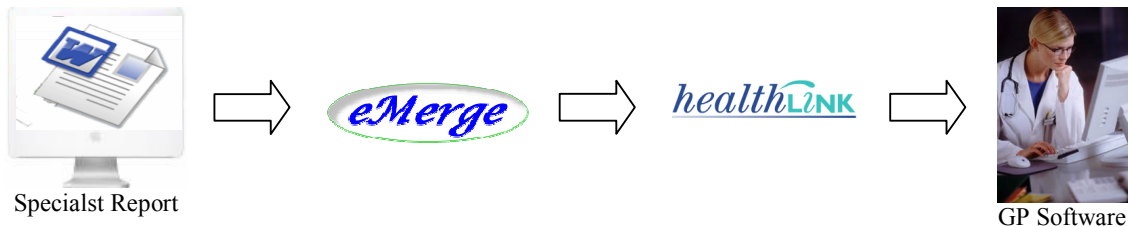




E-merge is a simple, easy to use software application that allows medical specialists, allied health professionals and laboratories to convert Microsoft Word reports into PIT electronic format.

E-merge converts the text within a Microsoft Word document into PIT format, renames the file appropriately and moves the new electronic file into another folder for despatch using Healthlink Messaging Software.



E-merge ensures that a file conforms to PIT specifications and as such allows these files to be imported into Clinical Medical Software Applications used by health professionals throughout Australia.

Electronic PIT File reports can be easily generated with a few clicks of the mouse and be despatched to the recipient within seconds of completion time.

Setting up E-merge is a simple procedure and only requires addition of the Provider Number of the Medical Practitioner. The Provider Number is linked in E-Merge to the Healthlink EDI code which ensures secure delivery of reports in encrypted form to the correct addressee.
